Create a Culture Innovation Fund that recognizes and supports innovative cultural initiatives that address social priorities and opportunities. The fund will contain some targeted monies to support the development of culture hubs in communities – places like libraries and museums. Nova Scotia needs more innovative community clusters as engines that enhance economic, social, and cultural activities in our cities and towns. Examples:
